Manually Programming the VX10

To enter the basic service programming mode and program the VX10:

1. Power on the phone
2. Press the **Menu** key, Press the **0 (Zero)** key.
3. Enter **000000** (Six Zeros)
4. Screen will display **Service** with 4 options
5. Press the **1** Key to enter the Service Programming Mode.
6. The ESN will appear. Press the soft key under **OK**.
7. Enter the 10-digit phone number. Press the soft key under **OK**.
8. Enter the NAM 1 Home SID. Press the soft key under **OK**.
9. Enter the NAM 1 Home Name. Press the soft key under **OK**.
10. Display will read, "Basic NAM 1 programming is complete."
[EXIT] [MORE]
11. Press the soft key under [Exit].
12. Display will read "Exit Service Programming" and then disappear.

Phone will power down, and power back up.

Text Messaging

1. Press Center Navigation Key up
2. Press 2 Key
3. Enter destination phone number
4. Press Left soft key, and select Continue
5. Enter message
6. When finished, press left soft key and select Send

How to Access the Internet

The VX10 is Web Browser capable, and can be accessed by pressing the 0 (Zero) key on the bottom of the keypad until the Web Browser page is displayed.

An alternate method to access the Web Browser:

1. Press Center Navigation Key Upward
2. Press Center Navigation Key to the Right
3. Press 1 to Start Web Browser

OTA Instructions

1. Perform the usual billing system activation procedure
2. Power up the phone and enter the Star Code, ***228 + [send]**, on the handset
3. The following audio message will be heard:

"Welcome to Verizon Wireless' Over The Air programming. This call is airtime free. Press '1' to program your phone. Press '2' to update your roaming capabilities."

Note: Programming will take up to 2 minutes. Should the programming exceed 45 seconds, the following audio message will be repeated at 25 second intervals: "Please continue to hold. Your phone is being programmed."

You will hear an audio message once the phone has been successfully programmed.
