How to Push to Talk

Getting Started

Customers can follow the steps below to create a Push to Talk contact list through the Internet.

Note: The customer must complete these steps to create a contact list. Once created via the web site, the contact list will automatically appear on the handset once the user power-cycles the device.

If the customer subscribes to the Vblock feature, it must be deactivated during the registration process

Access www.vzwpushtotalk.com from a desktop or laptop computer.

Click Create a User Profile (customer will be linked to vtext site) and enter the 10-digit mobile number.

Click Send. The system will validate the customer, as a Push to Talk customer if subscribed to Push to Talk, and the following message will display: "Your password has been sent to your mobile device." Enter the temporary password received by a text message. Create a new password. The password must be between 5-12 alphanumeric characters with no spaces (case sensitive).

Re-enter the password and click Save. Access www.vzwpushtotalk.com to log-in.

Helpful Hints

Manually Programming the V60p

- 1. Power Phone on
- 2. Enter 74663# Menu Menu. NAM 1 is highlighted
- 3. Press right soft key (Select). NAM 1 information will come up.
- 4. Press right soft key (Change). Screen will show MIN
- 5. Press Delete repeatedly until clear and then put in 10 digit number
- 6. Press scroll key down to CDMA, press right soft key (change)
- 7. Enter system ID. (MDN line will auto populate when the phone powers off and on. Press right soft key (OK)
- 8. Scroll down to AMPS System ID. Press right soft key (Change) and enter system ID.
- 9. Press right soft key (OK)
- 10. Press left soft key (done) to take you back to activation screen
- 11. Press left soft key (Exit)
- 12. Phone will power cycle.

OTA Instructions

- 1. Perform the usual billing system activation procedure
- 2. Power up the phone and enter the Star Code, *228 + [send], on the handset
- 3. The following audio message will be heard:

"Welcome to Verizon Wireless' Over the Air programming. This call is airtime free. Press '1' to program your phone. Press '2' to update your roaming capabilities."

Note: Programming will take up to 2 minutes. Should the programming exceed 45 seconds, the following audio message will be repeated at 25-second internals: "Please continue to hold. Your phone is being programmed."

You will hear an audio message once the phone has been successfully programmed

IP Address Programming

- 1. Press the Menu Key
- 2. Type in the following in a rapid key sequence. (0,7,3,8,8,7, *)
- 3. Prompt to enter six digit security code. (default is six zero's).
- 4. Then press OK Defaulted at web browser.

How to Send a Text Message

- 1. Press the Menu key
- 2. Scroll to Messages and press right soft key (Select)
- 3. Scroll to Create Message and press right soft key (Select)
- 4. Add a phone number, email address or choose a contact from your Phone Book and press right soft key (Ok)
- 5. Type your message and press right soft key (Ok)
- 6. Press the left soft key(Done)
- 7. "Send Message Now?" appears on your screen.
- 8. Press left soft key (Yes) to send Message
